- Conduct research on topics related to European security and resilience, economic policy, transatlantic relations, democratic challenges in Europe and global democratic trends.

- Support the organization of conferences, workshops, and expert discussions.
- Engage with policymakers, academics, and industry experts via interviews and networking.
- Assist with communications (drafting articles, newsletters, and social media content).

Required Qualifications

- Pursuing a bachelor's degree in political science, international relations, economics, European studies, or a related field.
- Demonstrated interest in European security and/or economic policy, EU governance or other areas of European policy making and/or interest in comparative politics, particularly around issues of democratic development.
- Strong research and analytical skills, with experience in academic or policy research.
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in a dynamic, international environment.
