



Summer Internship 2026: Communications Intern

Description

The Minda de Gunzburg Center for European Studies (CES) partners with the <u>Democracy and Culture Foundation</u> (DCF) to offer a pre-negotiated research internship opportunity at DCF for the summer of 2026.

DCF aims to empower society through citizen engagement and better governance. The Foundation identifies pressing issues, from migration to disinformation to climate change, and then undertakes a process of collective intelligence and deliberative democracy to propose concrete solutions to then enact through its own programs and those of partner organizations.

Location & Timeframe

The internship is based either in Athens or in Nafplio, Greece, with occasional travel to Athens. The working language is English. Timeframe: full-time, eight weeks – June and July 2026.

Compensation

This internship will be fully funded by CES. The funds will cover travel, accommodation, and food expenses.

Responsibilities

- Draft impactful messages for social media.
- Design visuals for social media based on existing models, templates, and branding.
- Edit videos of existing content.
- Analyze social media impact and metrics (impressions, interactions, followers) on a monthly basis.
- Explore new social media trends.
- Assist with newsletters (Mailchimp).
- Work with partners around advocacy and communications campaigns.
- Assist with website content support.
- Help the Communications Director with community building for the Foundation's Youth Program and Kofi Annan NextGen Democracy Prize thinking and strategy.
- Help the Communications Director with thought leadership strategy.
